Basin Park Art Fair Participation Rules & Policies

Set up: 8 a.m-9:45 a.m. ART IN THE PARK HOURS: 10a.m – 4p.m.

1. All work must be original, handcrafted work. One of a kind work is preferred and encouraged.
3. Reproductions and limited editions of original work are allowed.
4. Artist demonstrations (if applicable) are encouraged to engage audience.
5. Artists may display an Artist Statement, with the artist's picture, describing how and by whom the work is made and the materials used to make the work.
6. Artists must be present with their work for the entire day of the Fair.
7. All work must be for sale.
8. Booth/display areas: 10' x 10' booth, \$75 per location
9. Booth/display areas for students ages 10-18: 10'x10' booth, \$25 per location

To be considered you must complete this form in its entirety, email 4-5 pictures that best represent your work, and submit a brief biography or artist statement.
